IMPORTANT NOTE FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR:

The Pennsylvania Department of Education has approved the use of Flexible Instructional Days (FID) as an alternate form of instruction in place of a day otherwise canceled due to inclement weather or unforeseen emergency. The Eastern Westmoreland CTC has been approved for up to five (5) Flexible Instructional Days for the 2021-2022 school year for remote online learning. If there is doubt about the severity of the weather event and the possibility of face-to-face instruction still exists, a traditional school delay will likely be used. Families will be informed when the CTC utilizes a Flexible Instructional Day through the CTC's mass notification system. The day will run the same as the remote online learning days utilized last school year where learners will follow their normal schedule remotely. The CTC instructors will have your learner prepared to access Schoology or another approved Learning Management System for such occurrences. Paper/pencil options will also be made available.

On occasion, the CTC and your child's sending district may be running on different schedules. The following procedures will be followed on such occasion:

In the event that the CTC utilizes a Flexible Instructional Day and your child's sending school does not, your child will be assigned to a study hall and will access CTC remote learning from the school.

In the event that your child's sending school utilizes a Flexible Instructional Day and the CTC does not, your child will access CTC remote learning from home.

In the event that your child's sending school closes and the CTC is open OR utilizes a Flexible Instructional Day, your child will have the option to access CTC remote learning from home.

Attendance Expectations for Remote Learning - Flexible Instructional Days

Learners must check-in with their instructor by 8:30AM (for the morning session) or 12:30PM (for the afternoon session) via Schoology or other means as directed by their instructor. Learners that check-in after 8:30AM/12:30PM will be considered "Tardy" and will lose daily grade points.

Learners are to complete and submit assigned coursework by 11:00AM (for the morning session) or 2:45PM (for the afternoon session) as directed by their instructor. Learners that submit assigned coursework after 11:00AM/2:45PM will be considered "Tardy" and will lose points on their assignment.
