

Carpentry Fundamentals

36 hours \$500

This is a hands-on course that covers framing materials & methods for floors, walls, ceilings & roofs. Individuals will learn to correctly frame walls with openings, intersecting partitions, how to identify load bearing vs non-load bearing walls, layout walls, ceilings & rafters. Hands-on application will include the use of common power tools necessary for framing. Interior & exterior finishes will be covered along with basic installation of materials. Cost of course includes all materials and use of tools.

Cosmetology Teacher

500 hours \$12.50/hr

This program will train the enrollees for an entry-level instructional position, proper work habits, state board laws & regulations, management skills, & preparation for passing state board examination. Upon completion enrollees will be able to prepare lesson plans, course outlines, complete classroom presentations & demonstrations, understand evaluation methods & skills necessary to manage a successful business. Enrollees will also learn & understand how to teach a multi-level classroom as well as providing positive professional learning environment for all learning types. Enrollees who are interested in enrolling must hold a valid cosmetology license for the state of Pennsylvania. Enrollment will be rolling and limited to ten participants. Participants must commit to attending a minimum of 15 hours per week.

Build a Drone

27 hours \$500

Have you ever been interested in drones but don't know where to start? Perhaps you don't know anything about electronics or what's needed to build one of these increasingly popular machines. Are you the type that likes having the satisfaction of learning through hands-on in a project-based envi-

ronment? Then this class is for you! The content covered within will be suited for both the beginner as well as the more experienced Maker. Topics will include basic electronics, soldering, drone anatomy, and part selection. Using a simulator, you will also learn the basics of flight. As an added bonus, you will walk away with an impressive drone suitable for both casual hobby flying or more advanced purposes, such as first-person view (FPV) racing. The beauty of making it yourself is in knowing how to repair your drone after it crashes, which will happen. Participants will keep the drone they build.

Digital Photography

12 hours \$125

Learn how cameras work, the creative use of basic camera functions, the basics of composition & lighting. Explore different photographic subjects & styles & discuss equipment & accessories. You will learn techniques to help you develop a photographer's "eye". Cameras with interchangeable lenses are preferred, but not required.

Emission Inspector Certification (EEIC)

Approximately 9 hours \$150

Enrollees must be at least 18 years old and hold a valid driver's license.

Enhanced Emission Inspector Cert: Call for class schedule & registration. This course certifies mechanics to perform emission inspections.

M2K - Machining (offered through New Century Careers)

250-600 hours Free

Call for an application, testing & registration information.

This program offers training to people who want to become machinists & **are not currently working in machine shops**. This is a great opportunity to gain skills & experience needed to get a job in the manufacturing industry. It offers three levels: Manu-CNC Machine Operator, Machine Operator/Machinist Trainee, & Manual/CNC Machinist Trainee. It teaches basic operations of lathes, vertical milling machines, CNC machines, pedestal grinders, saws, drill presses, surface grinders, & various shop tools. You choose the days you are able to attend.

Masonry Fundamentals

36 hours \$350

An introduction to masonry in the form of laying out & planning projects, spreading mortar, laying of brick, block or architectural stone, & jointing of masonry units. Cost estimating & analysis will be covered as well. Enrollees will have an introduction to restoring/repairing of masonry issues & the ability to learn project specific samples as well (i.e., outdoor fireplaces, patios, brick planters, fish ponds, bake ovens, concrete sidewalks, retaining walls, etc.)

Microsoft Excel

30 hours \$250

This is a hands-on course that covers basic functions of Microsoft Excel 2016. Individuals will learn the use of templates, formulas & functions as well as data handling including importing, filtering, & formatting data. Additional topics covered will include macros, workbook security, & using charts & graphics within worksheets. This course is aligned with the Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) exam 77-727. One attempt for the Microsoft Excel 2016 certification exam will be offered at the completion

Individuals will learn the various processes on how to join copper, PEX, & CPVC used for water line installation. These methods include soldering, pro press, mechanical compression & solvent weld. Basic plumbing trouble shooting, repair & replacement of faucets, toilets & sink traps will also be explained in depth.

Safety Inspection

Approximately 26 hours \$200

Enrollees must be at least 18 years old and hold a valid driver's license.

Using the latest versions of Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, Indesign) explore a hands-on approach to learn how to utilize the industry standard software. Projects include: color correcting images, basic logo design, & graphic design. For enrollees desiring further professional certification, testing as an Adobe Certified Associate is available for \$50 per test attempt. Individuals with intermediate to advanced skills may choose to skip directly to a review & attempt a certification exam at a reduced cost.

Welding Fundamentals

40 hours \$500

Enrollees learn oxyacetylene & shielded metal arc welding techniques along with various tools & equipment relative to the welding industry.
