215. PROMOTION AND RETENTION	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>Pol. 213</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes that the emotional, social, physical and educational development of students will vary and that students should be placed in the educational setting most appropriate to their needs. The Joint Operating Committee will establish and maintain high standards for each program and monitor student achievement in a continuous and systematic manner.</p> <p>A student shall advance when she/he has successfully achieved the academic standards and student competencies established for the present level, based on the professional judgment of the teachers and the results of assessments. A student shall advance to the next level by demonstrating mastery of the required skills and knowledge.</p>
<p>2. Delegation of Responsibility Title 22 Sec. 4.12, 4.13 Pol. 100</p>	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop administrative regulations for promotion and retention of students which assure that every effort will be made to remediate the student's difficulties before the student is retained.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines</p>	<p>The building administrator shall be assigned the final responsibility for determining the promotion or retention of each student.
