224. CARE OF CENTER PROPERTY	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee believes that the center should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.
2. Authority	The Joint Operating Committee charges each student in the center with responsibility for the proper care of the center property, supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.
SC 777 Pol. 218, 233	It is the policy of the Joint Operating Committee that students who damage center property may be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface center property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and Guardians may be held financially accountable for the actions of the student.
SC 1338	The Joint Operating Committee may report to appropriate law enforcement any student who damages center property.
3. Delegation of Responsibility SC 109, 801	The Administrative Director or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy. The Administrative Director shall report to the JOC serious incidences of vandalism.
