231. SOCIAL EVENTS AND SCHOOL TRIPS	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee recognizes the value of student social events and class trips in enhancing and enriching the school experience for students.
2. Authority SC 511	The Joint Operating Committee shall make center facilities available and provide appropriate staff for social events within the center's facilities that have been approved by the Administrative Director. School or school related trips and social events that take place either overnight or out of state shall require approval by the Joint Operating Committee.
3. Guidelines SC 1850.1	As voluntary participants in center social events and school trips, students shall be held responsible for compliance with Joint Operating Committee policies and the center's rules. Infractions of those policies and rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures applied during the regular center program. Participation in center events is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the policies and rules of the center.
4. Delegation of Responsibility SC 511	The Administrative Director shall develop administrative regulations for the conduct of student social events and school trips which include the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Designation of a staff member who shall be the Joint Operating Committee employee responsible for the event. 2. Provision of adequate adult supervision as required by the circumstances of the event. 3. Formulation of rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of all participants and distribution of such rules and regulations to all students and adults involved. <p>References: School Code – 24 P.S.
