307. STUDENT TEACHERS/INTERNS	
1. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee encourages cooperation with colleges and universities within the state to assist in the training of student teachers and interns for vocational technical education.</p>
<p>SC 111 Title 22 Sec. 8.1 et seq 23 Pa. C.S.A. Sec. 6301 et seq</p>	<p>Student teachers and interns shall not be accepted into the center unless they have complied with the mandatory background check requirements for criminal history and child abuse and the center has evaluated the results of those screening processes.</p>
<p>SC 111</p>	<p>Student teachers and interns shall report arrests and convictions as required by law. Failure to accurately report such arrests and convictions may, depending on the nature of the offense, subject the individual to criminal prosecution.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall be responsible to assign student teachers and interns to the center's programs.</p>
<p>SC 1418 Title 28 Sec. 23.43, 23.44, 23.45 Pol. 314</p>	<p>Recommendations for selection of cooperating teachers shall be made by the building administrator, with the agreement of the college or university supervisor.</p> <p>Student teachers and interns shall comply with the health examination requirements of the state and Joint Operating Committee policy applicable to center staff.</p> <p>While serving in the center, student teachers and interns may be responsible for their conduct to the supervising teacher and building administrator.</p>
