RELATIONS WITH PARENTS/GUARDIANS</p> <p>During school hours, the Joint Operating Committee acts in loco parentis, or in place of the parents/guardians, through its designated administrators.</p> <p>Parents/Guardians are requested to keep EWCTC apprised of changes in the home situation that may affect a student's conduct or performance.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that the following activities be implemented to encourage cooperation between parents/guardians and EWCTC:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parent-teacher conferences to permit two-way communication between home and the center. 2. Meetings of parents/guardians and staff members to explain and discuss matters of general interest. 3. Meetings of staff members and groups of parents/guardians of those students having special abilities, disabilities, needs, or problems. 4. An open house in the center to provide parents/guardians the opportunity to see the facilities, meet the faculty and witness center programs. <p>The Joint Operating Committee believes that parents/guardians have a responsibility to support and encourage their child's career in the center through the following actions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Require that students observe all Joint Operating Committee policies and center rules and regulations and accept responsibility for their behavior. 2. Send children to the center with proper attention to their health, personal cleanliness and dress.

Maintain an active interest in the student's daily work and provide appropriate supervision for completion of assigned homework.4. Read, sign and return promptly all communications from the center, when requested.5. Attend conferences set up for the exchange of information on the student's progress.6.
